A Safe Space Training has been updated!

A Safe Space training will help you create an environment where girls can be safe and have fun. There are now four levels of training.

All volunteers will need to do Level 1 unless you've done *A Safe Space* training in the last three years. The previous *A Safe Space* training is equivalent to Level 1 and 2 of this updated training. Do you have the correct training? Check the training required for your role <u>here</u>.

A Safe Space, Level 1

• For all volunteers including occasional helpers, GO coordinators, home contacts, peer educators and young leaders.

A Safe Space, Level 2

• For leaders, assistant leaders, unit helpers, leaders in training, young leaders, peer educators and those that are doing level 3 and 4.

A Safe Space, Level 3

• For anyone leading a team of adults, at least one leader per unit must have level 3.

A Safe Space, Level 4

• For all commissioners.




1st Abercynon Guides and Rangers have done litter picking around their local community of Abercynon.
