
Girlguiding Cymru Book Bus 2019, Zambia

This summer 4 members of Central Glamorgan were lucky enough to attend an international adventure to Livingstone, Zambia to volunteer with The Book Bus. The Book Bus is a charity who works with children in rural schools and communities to develop their English via reading and related activities. We had an amazing time sharing stories and songs with children from another culture. Unforgettable memories were made both in the schools and the libraries, everywhere we went children were smiling, waving and asking us to read with them. 7 girls and 2 leaders were chosen from Girlguiding Cymru international selection, between us we took out over a year's worth of resources, which will be used by The Book Bus volunteers to deliver literacy activities.
